- 500-word limit, which includes required subheadings
- References, if included, do not count toward the 500-word limit
- Required subheadings
  - Research Abstracts: Introduction, Purpose, Methods, Results, Implications
  - EBP Abstracts: Problem, Evidence, Implementation, Outcomes, Recommendations
- Submit abstracts for blind review electronically via the NCONL website at <http://nconl.org/>
- Review criteria available online
- Submission deadline: **August 1, 2011**
- Presenting author of posters accepted for presentation will be notified by September 15, 2011
- Note: poster presenters must be registered for the symposium. The primary presenter will receive a reduced registration rate.
